

# Membership Report 2023

137 members in total for 2023, down from 144 last year. Overall membership has remained consistent at the 2020 level.

In general terms, the number of non-renewals (18) was matched by the addition of new members (19), with the couch/track to Green course contributing strongly to those numbers. The loss of members due to their transfer out to other clubs mostly accounts for difference in year-end figures.

Sadly, we also lost two Life Members this year – Judith Robb and Raymond Snaith.

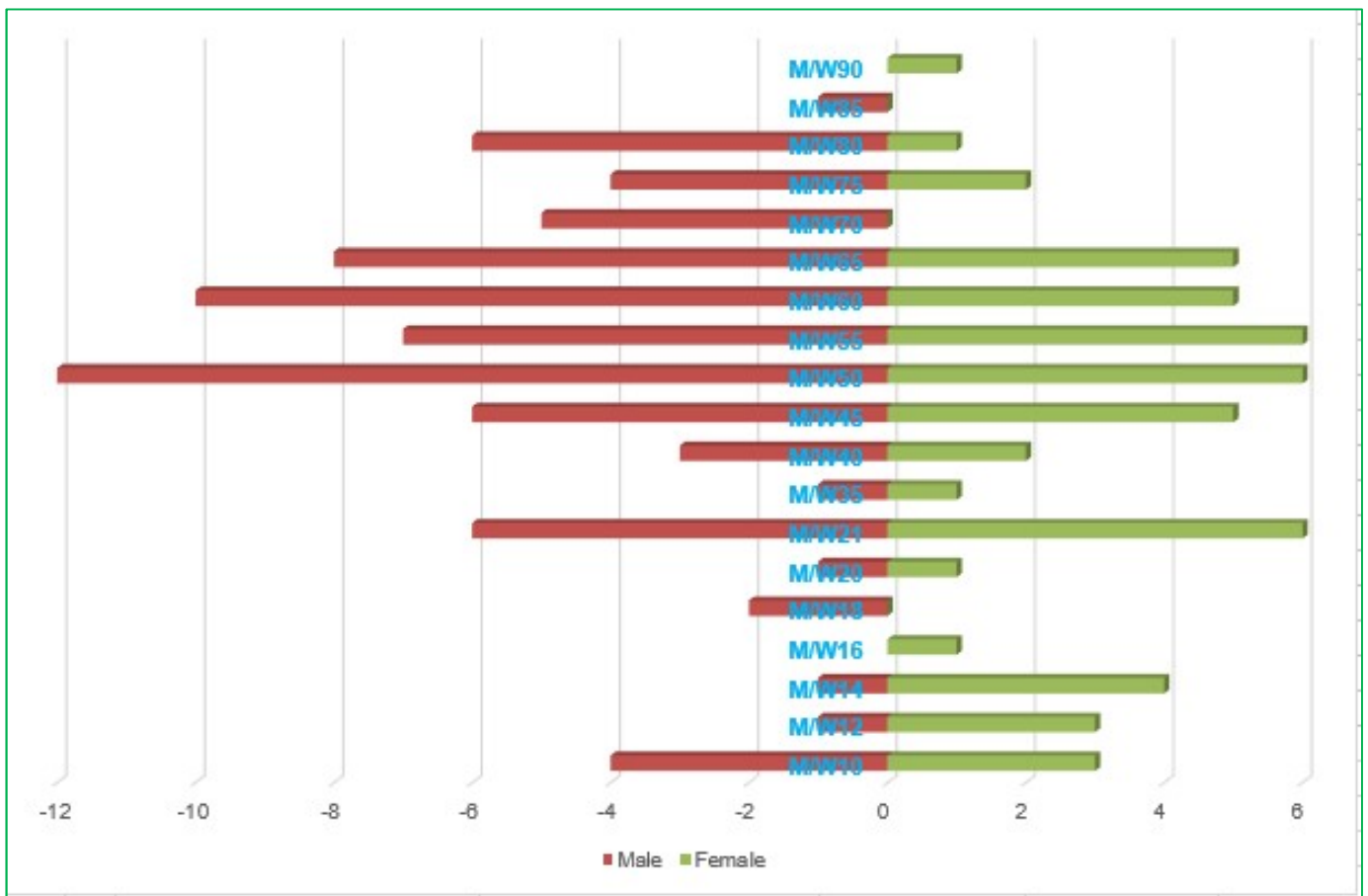
Committee decided this year to stop using the term Life Member and Honorary Member in future and introduce one class of membership to cover all none running members.

Benefits to the social member:

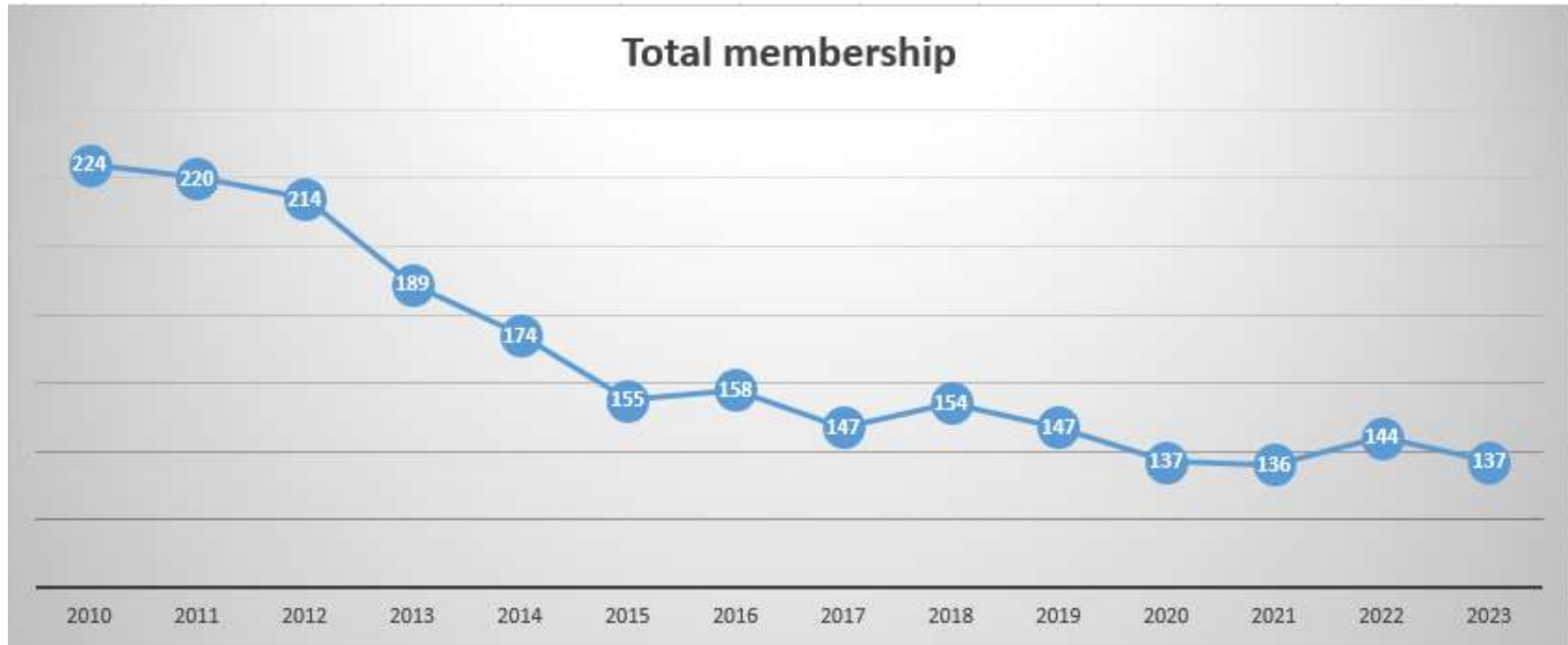
- Receive Tchimes and have access to members area on web site.
