Here is the list of purchases which I am requesting today.

- 1. New Brother Splits Printer 700. Same as the last one we got, using same sticky back paper rolls. The older, slightly misfiring Brother 550 will be kept in reserve. May need it for CSC. @ **£72.50***
- 2. Two new Master Stations used for programming boxes and for Downloading at events (including safety downloads). We have 3 currently (two purchased including batteries in 2009!) We will still use these sometimes. They are working fine, but could pack up at any time, and new ones will work significantly faster. @ **£107.28 = £214.56.***
- 3. Three coupling sticks (one to go with each laptop) to link control boxes with Master.. Our two current ones are still fine with older Si boxes and Master boxes, but no good for the new smaller, control & master, boxes. We have 2 other suitable ones currently attached to small blue Clear boxes - we would keep those in use. @ **£6.36 each = £19.08.***
- 4. Three purple Service Off dibbers (used to switch off Si boxes. We have 3 currently but it is very important to use these to save battery life so good to give to both Planner & Organiser. @ **£11.45 = £34.35.***

Total spend = £340.49
